

Decisions taken during the 12<sup>TH</sup> Central Police Welfare Committee Meeting held on July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2015 are as under:

1.	Enhancement in Special Welfare Relief <b>from ₹10.00 lakhs to ₹12.00 lakhs and immediate relief from ₹25,000/- to ₹50,000/-</b> payable to NOK of subscriber in the event of his death while in service <b>out of contributory Police Welfare Fund.</b>															
2. 3.	Welfare loan up to <b>₹1.00 lakh</b> shall be applicable for treatment / higher education / self marriage and marriage of children of the subscribers towards Police welfare Fund.															
4.	Enhancement in availing of welfare loan from existing two <b>(2) times to three (3) times only</b>															
5.	Relaxation in taping of GPF advances in respect of personnel falling under NPS category for availing welfare loan/ relief on the existing provisions.															
6.	In addition to existing provisions Serving Police Personnel suffering from life terminal disease shall also be allowed to avail immediate refundable assistance of <b>₹2.00 lakhs</b> out of Police Pariwar Fund, depending on the nature of case.															
7.	Meritorious scholarship enhanced <b>from ₹200/- to ₹250/- P.M</b> for class 8th and 9th in respect of wards of <b>serving Police Personnel</b> securing above 75% marks.															
8.	Enhancement of scholarship <b>from ₹200/- to ₹250/- P.M to the wards of deceased Police personnel (other than militancy related) for three wards for pursuing studies up to graduation level.</b>															

9. DGP rewards shall be awarded as per following ratios depending upon the percentage of marks secured by the wards of serving Police Personnel.

10. In addition to existing provisions **Award of ₹10,000/- with certificate from DGP** to the wards of serving Police personnel qualifying **National Level Competitive Examinations like AIEEE,JEE (IIT), AIPME, IIM and other similar All India Entrance Examinations.** The expenditure on this account shall be debited to Central Police Welfare Fund.

11. Provision of scholarship of **₹15,000/- P.A** in addition to existing provisions in respect of wards of Police Personnel killed in militancy related incidents **pursuing Ph.D or equivalent courses.**

12. Provision of Bara Khan enhanced from **existing scale to ₹30,000/- only.**

13. Existing scale of spectacle charges enhanced to **₹1000/-** in each case.

14. Adoption of :  
i) Pardhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY) for SPO's,  
ii) Pardhan Mantri jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY) for willing SPO's (**Optional**) for which **50% premium** shall be borne by the department **out of Police Pariwar Fund.**

15. Special relief of SPO's enhanced from ₹1.00 lakh to ₹2.00 lakhs with immediate relief of ₹10000/- for conducting last rites of the deceased SPO. The existing scale of subscription shall be enhanced by ₹30/- P.M per head subject to enhancement of honorarium of SPO's till then the expenditure on the enhancement shall be debited to Police Pariwar Fund.

16. **Group Health insurance Policy at the monthly premium of ₹300/- per head shall be taken up for one year applicable up to five dependents for cashless treatment up to ₹5.00 lakhs.**

**Note: - The enhanced scales for all the above benefits shall be applicable prospectively from July, 8<sup>th</sup> 2015 (8.07.2015).**

In addition to above, other agenda points relating to service matters were also discussed and decided to be taken up with the Government at appropriate level (.)
