**Clarifications With Regard to Inventory Management System**

S No	Query
1.	<p>Elimination of offline module option from inventory Management Solution?</p> <p><b>Clarification:</b> Offline module is essential requirement of the system as similar type of module/functionality in ambitious nationwide CCTNS project is implemented with great success. It would have been impossible to implement CCTNS project in J&amp;K state without such functionality/facility. However, removal of offline module can be considered at later stage of the project implementation subject to project success.</p>
2.	<p>Surrender of application Source Code to avoid cost escalation?</p> <p><b>Clarification:</b> Agreed. No need to supply source code of front-end application software. However, all the back-end data including any procedures, functions, triggers, views, tables etc need to be always made available.</p>
3.	<p>Removal of CMMI certification clause.</p> <p><b>Clarification:</b> Cannot be removed. No compromise on standard and quality of application software and proposed solution.</p>
4.	<p>Marks for past experience and turn over clause.</p> <p><b>Clarification:</b> Only five (05) marks each for past experience (Sr. No. 06) and turn over (Sr. No. 09) clause. Consequently, overall weightage shall be given as follows:- (a) Technical Score: 0.55 (b) Financial Score: 0.45</p>
5.	<p>Implementation of solution on low cost broad connectivity.</p>

	<p><b>Clarification:</b> This option is already under consideration. Intending bidders should have no problem in customising their solution either through dedicated leased line or low cost internet connection. However, any security certificate (https://) involved in hosting of the application will be borne by the bidder. If the solution is hosted/exposed through public domain, need for requirement of offline module will be decided/conveyed by the department accordingly.</p>
6.	<p><b>Important.</b> The need for stationing of manpower in each Range Hqrs numbering 07 may not be required initially till the necessary database hosting, basic application customization and implementation is completed at central location of PHQ and to primary stores of Srinagar/Jammu. However stationing for the period as already explained in the queries issued earlier shall remain same.</p>
7.	<p>Submission of tender fee in place of treasury challan.</p> <p><b>Clarification:</b> The intending bidders who do not have the J&amp;K Govt. treasury in their area of location can upload the copy of demand draft on Govt e-NIT Website and send the original to PHQ.</p>
