Monthly Newsletter of 4 pages or multiple of 04 pages (In Multi-Colour Printing - in English/ Urdu as per availability of material) on imported Art paper of 130 GSM with Centre pinning & cover pages with imported Art Card Paper 220 GSM with lamination. (Paper size: 22 Cms x 28 Cms).

REQUIREMENT One thousand two hundred (1200) copies per issue.

The details of material for printing of Newsletter along-with sample/ specimen can be seen in the office of undersigned on all working days from 10 am to 4 pm upto March 31, 2018.

The tenders should reach to the office of the ADGP Armed J&K Jammu by or before April 07, 2018 up to 4 pm through Registered Post/ Speed Post or By Hand under sealed cover clearly marked as "Tender for Printing of J&K Police Newsletter for the year 2018-19".

The tenders shall be opened on April 09, 2018 at 3 pm by the Tender Opening Committee in presence of the tenderers or their authorized representatives who may like to be present in the Office chamber of Staff Officer to ADGP Armed, J&K, Gulshan Ground, Jammu.



(TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF NIT NO. 01 OF 2018 DATED 14/03/2018)

Annexure-"A"

1. The rates quoted for printing of Newsletter should be **per four pages** for One thousand two hundred (1200) copies of Newsletter inclusive of all charges i.e. composing, scanning/planning designing, plate making, cost of paper and all kind of taxes/GST etc if any. The rates quoted shall also apply to the printing of special issues/Annual issue of the Newsletter for more pages (Multiples of four pages) of the same specifications on need basis.
2. Each tender should be accompanied by earnest money of Rs.5000/- in shape of CDR of any scheduled Bank, **pledged to S.O to ADGP Armed J&K**. A photocopy of dealership/registration certificate of the printing firm, as an SSI Unit with State Industries Department or under the companies Act, must also accompany the tender without which the tenders will not be entertained.
3. Successful tenderers shall have to complete the printing work conforming to the quality and specifications and deliver printed material at APHQ Srinagar (from May 2018 to October 2018) and at APHQ Jammu (from November 2018 to April 2019) within ten days of the receipt of supply order.
4. The CDRs of the un-successful tenderers will be returned after finalizing the process for award of contract whereas the CDR of the successful tenderer would be released / returned after successful completion of annual contract for the year 2018-19. Tender should be free from cuttings and overwriting. Mutilated tenders shall not be accepted.
5. The payment of the bill will be made as and when the funds under the particular Head are available in APHQ.
6. The contract/ supply order can be repudiated at any time, if the supplies are not made according to the entire satisfaction of the Department in light of terms & conditions. It shall be at the absolute discretion of the department to ask for replacement in lieu of the rejected supply.
7. VAT/ Income Tax clearance upto December 2017 should be enclosed with the tender.
8. No conditional tender shall be accepted.
9. All legal proceedings arising out of any dispute between parties shall have to be instituted in courts situated in Jammu/ Srinagar only.
10. If after the placement of orders, the successful tenderer backs out, the security deposit will be forfeited, besides other remedial penal measures shall be taken against him.
11. The decision of the accepting authority shall be final as to the quality of the material
12. The successful supplier shall have to make the supplies to the department within the period stipulated in supply order, failing which penalty at Re-1% per day over the estimated cost of indented supplies or 25% of the total cost which ever be the lesser shall be imposed for the belated period.

The undersigned reserves the right to accept or reject any tender without assigning any reason thereof.
