



1. For and on behalf of the Governor J&K State, sealed tenders are invited from original manufacturers and approved authorized dealers affixing revenue stamp worth Rs 5/- duly sealed with sealing wax and stamp of the tenderer, for the supply of **Traffic Items, as detailed hereunder**, Approved/authorized dealers will attach valid & authenticated copy of authorization of original manufacturer, **without which tender shall be rejected.**

Item 01	Chargeable Traffic Signal Hand Rods (Batons): Qty: 200 no.'s tentatively. Led and Fluorescent cast vinyl film in the bar emits highly visible signals. Made of Polycarbonate material, exceedingly durable and crystal clear transparent colour read, suitable for Traffic Police and highway Patrol Dimension:- Length-540 mm, diameter 43 mm. It can be operated by two-way switch for blinking as well as flash light.
Item 02	Hand Gloves:- Qty 500 no's tentatively. Fluorescent reflective type. A high quality range of PVC hand gloves that includes reflective jackets, caps, gloves, and batons. These apparels have high visibility or available in fluorescent orange/yellow colour. The visibility of these apparels should enhance during the night by the use of reflective strips.
Item 03	Traffic Helmets:- Qty 400 no.'s tentatively, light or dark blue. They are made by using very heavy and fine quality raw material that ensure high durability at its user end.
Item 04	Night Safety Belts:- Qty 800 no.'s tentatively. Fluorescent orange / green / yellow colour fabric. Using Reflecting Tape/ Reflective Fabric/ Micro Prismatic PVC Tape/ Heat Transfer. Choice of Velcro , Button or Chain for front Locking, Logos at front or back (printed or reflective). Reflective Film/Tape. Reflective Heat Transfer Film/Tape. Goldian Tape Floor Marking Tapes. Hazard Marking Tapes.
Item 05	P.A.System:- Qty 40 no.'s tentatively. Should be easily mounted on vehicles (Gypsies, TATA Sumo's and Motor Cycles) and the output should be clear to the listeners. Public Address System should have microprocessor based communication system, loud speakers, amplifiers, microphones, panels and telephones, integration with EPBAX and fire alarm system.
Item 06	Traffic Masks:- Qty.2000 no' tentatively. Should be of good quality, effective in anti-pollution, easy to wear. A complete protection against harmful fuel emission in the city life. They should be made of quality raw material. It safeguard against environment toxins and atmospheric pollutions.
Item 07	Tint Meters:- Qty.30 no.'s tentatively. LCD display measurement range should be 0 to 100% light transmission. Should operate in below zero temperatures. Power consumption should be less and light in weight.

2. Last date and time for receipt of sample will be 15-01-2015. Samples received after the prescribed date time shall not be accepted. The sample shall be packed in a separate cover affixed with sealing wax and seal of the firm, quoting NIT & Annexure detail and shall received on THQ CID Complex Jammu and RTHQ Complex Polo view Srinagar.
3. The tenders shall be properly sealed and addressed to **IGP Traffic J&K, at their office located in CID Complex, Canal Road (near RRL Jammu) Jammu- 180001.** The tender envelops shall be super scribed "**Tender for Traffic items "NIT No. / dated**
4. The tender fee has been fixed at Rs 500/- which shall accompany the tender offer only, in the shape of a **crossed demand draft** favouring Accounts Officer THQ, J&K payable at Jammu. The

tender fee is not refundable and the same will be deposited into Govt. Treasury under Head 0055-Police for the year 2014-15
 The local SSI units are required to pay the tender fee prescribed as per J&K Govt rules. However, the Govt/Semi-Govt. concerns of the J&K State claiming exemption shall append authenticated orders, certificates etc. issued by competent authority in support of their claim. **Tenders without tender fee shall be rejected.**

5. Inspections:
 The department reserves the right to carryout 03 inspections (at various stages of fabrications) of the items at the location of the successful vendor. The successful vendor shall facilitate such inspections at his work place/plant etc. as the case may be.

6. TWO BID SYSTEM:
 All bidders are required to submit their offers in two covers as under:-

(A) FIRST COVER (Technical Bid) should contain the following:-

1	Tender documents duly completed and signed BUT WITHOUT INDICATING THE RATES QUOTED;
2	Earnest Money;
3	Tender fee;
4	Technical specifications of the item quoted alongwith original catalogues;
5	Delivery terms, delivery period quoted;
6	Lab test report, if any, should not be older than the date of issue of this tender notice;
7	List of the orders received and executed during last two years giving reference of the order; value of order, name of the agency/department alongwith performance certificate;
8	Registration of certificate/Industrial License of original manufacturer, for the material quoted;
9	Certificate of being authorized dealer having authorization of the original manufacturer to quote against the tender;
10	Authorised dealer having authorisation to quote against this tender, shall furnish his Registration Certificate with Central/State Sales Tax Department;
11	A copy of this NIT duly signed & stamped on every page by the tenderer, in token of having understood and accepted the specification, terms & conditions of the NIT

B) Second Cover (commercial /Price Bid) Should contain the following:-

1	Details of rates duties, taxes. These details should be submitted on their letter pad. Note:- J&K State entry tax rate currently is 13.5% extra. J&K Police does not issue Road Permits Or Concessional Forms and therefore Rate so quoted shall be F.O.R. Consignee.
2	Rates must be clearly written in figures as well as in words, free from over writings, cuttings and alterations. Rates quoted should be on firm price basis;
3	Tenders shall be filled in clearly and with one ink. No cuttings/alterations/over-writings shall be made in the tender. Correction, if any, be done clearly and properly initialled;
4	AMC charges can be shown separately.

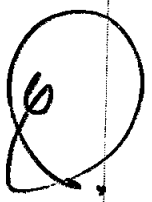
Both the above mentioned covers should be sealed separately, and super scribed with the Tender No., name of item/stores and date of tender opening. This cover should thereafter, be kept in a third cover and again sealed. This cover should also be super scribed with the tender No., item/stores and date of opening.

7. **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)**

The intending tenderer/s will have to send the Earnest Money in shape of CDR/FDR only from any Nationalized bank, @ Rs.10,000/-(Rupees ten thousand only) pledged to IGP Traffic J&K with the tender offer, which shall be valid for one year. The EMD in the case of un-successful tenderer shall be released after finalization of Tender, where-as in the case of successful tenderers it will be adjusted towards the security money (required to be deposited) on application, for due performance of the agreed contract/performance during the warranty period; No interest shall be payable by purchaser on the EMD deposited by the tenderer.

J&K Govt. rules with regard to furnishing of EMD in respect of local Registerer! SSI units shall be applicable in letter and spirit. The local SSI units are required to pay the EMD prescribed as per J&K Govt rules. For the purpose, SSI units shall have to furnish Registration Certificate and Functional Certificate of SSI Unit, issued by the competent authority with their tender offer failing which the benefits of SSI units will not be allowed.

The Government/ Semi Govt. or similar other concerns, claiming exemption from the payment of EMD shall have to append duly authenticated orders, certificate etc. from competent authority



- supporting their claims. **Tenders without EMD shall be rejected.**
- 8. **Security Deposit.** The approved tenderers will have to supply the articles as per approved rate, approved sample and specification till the validity of the contract. They will have to furnish **security deposit @ 5%** of the total value of the items contracted for, in the shape of CDR/FDR from a Nationalized Bank, at the time of signing of **Deed of Agreement** to ensure satisfactory performance of the equipment supplied, for Warranty period, from the date of acceptance of product. This security deposit will be released in due course after the expiry of specified warranty period/agreed contract. The charges on stamps etc. (cost of documents in totality) shall be borne by the supplier while executing the agreement. (No interest shall be paid by the purchaser on the Security deposit). J&K Govt Rules for Security deposit in respect of local SSI Units shall be applicable.
- 9. **Despatch Instructions;** Stores are required to be delivered at Consignee's location (Jammu), at freight, risk and cost of the supplier.
- 10. **Tender offers shall be liable for rejection in absence of following documents:-**

i.	Registration Certificate/Industrial Licence of original manufacturer, for the material quoted.
ii.	Authorised Dealer having authorisation to quote against this tender, shall furnish his Registration Certification with Central/State Sales Tax department.
iii.	A copy of this NIT duly signed & stamped on every page by the tenderer, in token of having understood and accepted the specifications, terms & conditions of the NIT.
iv.	Delivery of stores will have to be completed within two months from the date of order or as would be specified in the supply order.
v.	Rates including duties, taxes, freight, insurance complete quoted shall be final till the validity of the contract with a provision of further extension if finally approved by State Level Purchase Committee for J&K Police Department. Note: J&K Police does not issue Road Permits OR Concessional Forms, and therefore Rate so quoted shall be F.O.R. Consignee. i.e. (THQ Jammu/Srinagar).
- 11. No conditional tender will be accepted/ entertained. It will be summarily rejected. No other condition, than those mentioned (in the terms set-forth) will be entertained;
- 12. Tender offers alongwith specifications shall be received by Traffic Police Headquarters J&K at abovementioned address **upto 15.01.2015 upto 1600 hours**. The department shall not be liable for any postal delays. No Tender will be accepted after the due date and time.
- 13. Tenders shall be opened on **18.01.2015 at 1100 hours at Traffic Police Hqrs J&K Jammu**. Only authorized representative will be allowed to attend the meeting for opening tenderers. He/She should also bring authority letter, duly signed and stamped on company/firm's letter head that any decision/negotiation taken by him/her would be accepted by company/firm. In case of unforeseen circumstances, the date of opening will be next working day.
- 14. The approved supplier shall be deemed to have fully understood the conditions, specifications, size, patterns, etc. of the article/s etc. to be supplied and in case of any doubt may seek clarification, either personally or on **Tel no; 0191-2566608**.
- 15. The supplies delivered by the successful tenderers shall be surveyed and verified at our Stores at Jammu or Srinagar (as may be indicated in the supply order) by the Survey Committee constituted for the purpose.
- 16. The successful tenderer shall have to enter into an agreement/deed on prescribed proforma (immediately after the issue of supply order) with the Department for due performance of the contract which shall be invariably furnished before the supply is made.
- 17. The period of delivery and validity may be extended, at absolute discretion of this Hqrs., provided the delay is justifiable.
- 18. After the rate is approved, if it is found subsequently that tenderer has supplied the same product at the rates lower than offered to THQ, the same rates will apply to J&K Police and the excess amount if any, paid to the firm shall be recovered from it in a suitable manner.
- 19. The tenderer is required to furnish an authenticated copy of latest Sales Tax/ VAT/ clearance certificates and PAN and VAT registration certificate(alongwith the tender offer or at the time of payments). The THQ shall be at liberty to put to scrutiny, verification etc. the Sales tax clearance so furnished by the successful tenderer.
- 20. Payment shall be released by the department against each consignment delivered, inspected, accepted and properly brought on stock in the concerned stock registers of the Department.
- 21. Remittance charges (Bank Commission) on payment made to the firms will be borne by the supplier. The charges of stamp/duty etc. as applicable shall be paid by the supplier while

	executing the agreement.
22.	As soon as the acceptance of the tender is communicated to the successful tenderer, the contract shall be binding on him. The EMD of the tenderer who backs out or withdraws his tender or fails to abide by it, after acceptance thereof, shall be forfeited. Besides other penal remedies that may be available to the Govt. of J&K, under the law shall also be charged to such defaulting tenderer.
	(a) If, after the registration/placement of orders/execution of the agreement and formally depositing the security money , the tenderer backs out or fails to supply the goods, the security deposit will be forfeited besides any other penal measures, the department may take, as per norms in vogue;
	b) The formal deed incorporating the terms of the contract will be executed by the successful tenderer immediately after receipt of supply order. Failure to execute such bond/deed shall not however prevent the contract from being enforced against the tenderer. Any loss sustained by the Govt. as a result of re-tendering the contract, shall be recovered from the defaulter, besides other penal measures as the department may deem proper;
	c) Goods shall be delivered (as per instructions in supply order) at THQ J&K, Jammu/ Srinagar, duly packed in perfect condition. The supplier if he so desires may insure the goods against loss or theft, destruction, damages by the natural calamity or loss by exposure to weather or other wise viz. war/rebellion, riot etc. The insurance charges will have to be borne by the supplier and the department shall not pay such charges;
	d) If, the successful tenderer fails to supply the goods of the prescribed specification or fails to deliver the goods within the stipulated period as specifically mentioned in the supply order, the department shall be at liberty to arrange supplies from other possible means, at his risk and cost. The department may give prior notice to the approved supplier in writing to make supplies good. In case of failure to supply the consignment on specified qualitative & quantitative terms, the department shall be lawfully entitled to forfeit the amount of the security money and take penal action to make good the loss sustained or excess cost incurred by the State in arranging of the supplies besides other remedies that may be available to the department, under the law for the time being in force in the state.
23.	The supplier shall not sublet the contract or any part thereof to any other agency.
24.	The decision of the accepting authority shall be final as to the quality of stores and shall be binding on the supplier. In case the articles supplied are not according to the approved specifications, they shall be rejected. The replacement of the rejected shall be at the sole discretion of the department. The loss caused due to rejection of the supplies shall be entirely borne by the supplier. The rejected equipment shall be lifted by the supplier within one week from the date of rejection. The department shall in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur to the rejected stores while those are in the premises of the consignee.
25.	The quantities indicated in the Tender Notification are tentative and this Headquarters reserves absolute rights to change the same (as per availability of funds) without any prior notification upto the validity of rate contract of this NIT.
26.	The authorities reserve absolute discretion to reject or accept any tender or a part thereof without assigning any reason and without any legal obligations. Any clause incorporated in the tender (not conforming to the NIT in any manner) shall make such an offer liable for rejection. Therefore, all the terms and conditions of the Tender Notice including technical specifications shall be carefully studied for the sake of complete and comprehensive tender. Failure to comply with any of the tender conditions or instructions or the offer with insufficient particulars/documents, which is likely to render fair comparison of tender as a whole impossible shall lead to rejection even if otherwise, it is a competitive offer/tender.
27.	Traffic Police Hqrs. reserves the right to add or suitably modify the terms and conditions (without prior notification) as per exigencies that may arise for one or the other reason/s.
28.	All legal proceedings arising out of any dispute between the parties shall have to be settled in the Courts situated in Jammu and Srinagar and not anywhere else.
