

Public Awareness Notice

J&K Police Recruitment Board (PRB) has been repeatedly trying to make aware the candidates in particular and their parents in general about the machinations of touts and middlemen who engage in different ploys to entice them/their wards, on one or the pretext to facilitate their selection in the ongoing recruitment process of constables in J&K Police. Since the recruitment process has been transparent all throughout, with the written examination of the eligible candidates also conducted in equally fair manner across the State with 98.6 percent attendance, such unscrupulous elements are reported to have again raised their ugly heads to fleece the gullible candidates. As a new tactic, these touts and contact men have been spreading rumours about the results of written test and short listing of candidates by resorting to circulating fabricated lists on social media which prompts the prospective candidates to enquire about their position from various corners.

Police Recruitment Board J&K (PRB) once again makes it abundantly clear that the candidates must have absolute faith in the transparency and fairness of selection process which is uninfluenced by any human intervention and will be based strictly on the performance of the candidates in the written examination recently held on 20th March 2016. The scanning and the evaluation process of the OMR answer scripts with the aid of technology, takes a considerable time and the PRB is in the process of concluding the selection process in a time bound manner which would take three to four weeks for the process to be completed. In all likelihood, by the end of April 2016 the whole selection process would be completed and selection list will be made public through media for which ample publicity will be made, around the last week of April 2016. Candidates are in their own interest advised to visit J&K Police official website: www.jkpolice.gov.in for regular updates and not to rely on any other unauthentic source of information.

It is therefore once again reiterated for the information of public in general and candidates in particular that there is no scope of any influence or interference in the recruitment process and as such all candidates are informed to be wary / cautious of such unscrupulous elements and not to heed to any such rumours that have been making rounds in the social media circles. Further if any such person/s approaches any candidate with the demand of money to facilitate his or her selection or circulates any such false and baseless so called selection list, the same should be brought to the notice of Police Recruitment Board or the local police.
