



Subject:- Tentative seniority List of Sub-Inspectors promoted/appointed during 2002.

Whereas, a final seniority list of Sub-Inspectors of J&K Executive Police appointed/promoted upto 29-12-2001 was issued vide PHQ Order No 2141 of 2014 dated 13-08-2014.

Whereas, before issuance of the final seniority list, a tentative seniority list of Sub-Inspectors of batch 2002 of Executive Police is required to be circulated among the concerned for inviting objections, if any, so as to formulate a final seniority list for further course of action.

Whereas, an advertisement notice under endorsement No Pers/ Rectt/ SIs/Executive/2001/25985-26065 dated 13-05-2001 was published to fill-up 89 available posts of Sub-Inspectors in J&K Executive Police through the direct recruitment process.

Whereas, after completing the recruitment process, the Recruitment Board formulated a selection list of 83 eligible candidates on provincial basis in terms of PHQ communication No Pers/A-405-II-2001-552-57 dated 03-01-2002 and kept 06 posts viz 04 under SC and 02 under ALC categories of Kashmir Province vacant due to non-availability of candidates belonging to such categories.

Whereas, after participating in the said recruitment process and failing to secure a place in the selection list, some candidates approached Hon'ble High Court through the medium of SWP Nos 196/2002, 162/2002, 87/2002 and 490/2002 seeking formulation of the said selection list at State Level on the plea that the Sub-Inspector post is a State Cadre Post. All the writ petitions were clubbed and the Hon'ble Single Bench decided SWP No 196/2002 titled Naresh Kumar Bhat and another vide common judgment dated 30-08-2002 with the observation that the view expressed by the Hon'ble Division Bench of the J&K High Court while deciding similar recruitment case of SIs of batch 1999-2000 in LPA (SWP No 336/2001) in case of State of J&K and others v/s Altaf Hussain & others dated 19-08-2002 shall be abiding. The operative portion of the said judgment passed by the Hon'ble Division Bench in the above LPA is as under:-

- I. *"The State Govt. would re-draw the merit list State wide within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this judgment.*
- II. *On re-drawing of the merit list, if the candidates who have already been selected/appointed and come within the merit zone, they would not be disturbed. But their seniority would be determined in accordance with the merit list which would be finally prepared.*
- III. *The State Govt. shall take an undertaking from selected candidates that they would join at the places as per allocation made by the State on the basis of their merit position.*
- IV. *While re-drawing the merit list, Rule 15 of the J&K Reservation Rules, 1994, would be kept in view, meaning thereby that reservation shall be made in accordance with the roster*

provided under Rule 14 of the said Reservation Rules, and the candidates obtaining higher merit would be appointed in terms of the category to which they belong."

Whereas, in pursuance to the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Single Bench dated 30-08-2002 and in light of the view expressed by the Hon'ble Division Bench, the selection record pertaining to the Sub-Inspectors of J&K Executive Police batch 2001-2002 was examined and the merit list was accordingly redrawn on State level in open as well as reserved categories in terms of PHQ Order No 4009 of 2004 dated 07-12-2004 whereby more candidates got enrolled in the department and some others were ousted.

Whereas, aggrieved by the above quoted PHQ Order, the ousted candidates approached the Hon'ble Court through the medium of SWP No 1613 of 2004 and CMP No 3090 of 2004 titled Azad Ahmad Pir and others v/s State and others for their continuation in the department. Interim directions passed by the Hon'ble Court are reproduced as under:-

".....subject to objections of the other side and till next date, the petitioners shall be permitted to continue. The respondents are at liberty to appoint the persons who are beneficiaries of the redrawn merit list against the available vacancies."

Whereas, the ousted candidates also approached the Hon'ble Supreme Court by way of a Special Leave Petition No 4805 of 2005, titled Azad Ahmad Pir and others v/s Vikas Basotra and others which was clubbed with Civil Appeal Nos 4804 & 4829 of 2005. These Appeals were disposed of by the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 31st of March, 2010. The operative portion of the court order is reproduced as under:-

".... However, the impugned judgment shall not operate as a precedent in future. We make it clear that the respondents in Civil Appeal Nos 4829 and 4804 of 2005 and appellants in Civil Appeal No 4805 of 2005 shall continue."

Whereas, in pursuance to the above referred Court directions, the ousted candidates who were in the department have not been disturbed and were allowed to continue their services.

Whereas, in compliance to the orders of Hon'ble Court, as discussed here-in-before, the seniority of Sub-Inspectors who came to be appointed after re-drawing the merit is to be fixed/determined in accordance with their initial merit which they had obtained during the selection process in contradiction to the procedure in vogue whereby such seniority is maintained on the basis of the merit obtained during the basic training.

Whereas, the candidates who came to be selected as a result of redrawn merit in the year 2004 in compliance to the above quoted Hon'ble Court directions, are entitled for notional seniority as per their induction merit with effect from the date their colleagues were selected in the year 2002.

Therefore, in light of the discussions made here-in-before, the seniority list of Sub-Inspectors appointed/promoted upto 2002, is hereby drawn as per the list forming annexure "A" of this order.

However, SIs figuring at S.No 1 to 5 of Annexure "A" were promoted to the present rank on 16-01-2002 i.e before enrolment of the directly recruited SIs of batch 2002. As such, they are placed ahead of the said batch in the seniority list. Further, Lady SI Kirti Sharma No EXJ025948 has been appointed as Sub-Inspector under SRO 43 in terms of Govt. Order No Home 245 (P) of 2002 dated 24-02-2002 and joined the department on 17-05-2002 i.e after the appointment of directly recruited SIs of batch 2002. Accordingly, she has been placed below these SIs and is figuring at S.No 89 of Annexure to this order. In addition to above, SI Rashid Ahmad Malik No 5960/NGO, who was promoted to the present rank on 19-05-2002 on his own seniority has been placed at the bottom of the seniority list of SIs of batch 2002.

The objections, if any, with regard to the placement, date of birth or any other ambiguity should reach to this Hqrs within 21 days from the issuance of this order. On expiry of the stipulated period, no objections shall be entertained and final seniority list shall be accordingly issued.
